Using kind words to solve problems

As a school we work hard to support children in all areas, a key area we are driving is for children to use kind words to solve problems. Conflict resolution is a key skill all of us need in life to be successful. We have created a script we are using for all children throughout the school to follow, this is present within classes and on the playground.

It would also be useful to have up at home to support your children and provide a consistent approach (if you would like a copy of this script, please ask your child's class teacher). As adults we must teach the children these important skills for this to be successful, we must all model this. The script looks like this:

Using kind words to solve problems



How to kindly ask someone to stop		
Steps		What to say?
1	Ask them kindly to stop	" <u>can</u> you please stop"
2	Tell them how you are feeling	"I feel sad/worried/cross"
3	Say what is making you feel that way?	"when you push me/say I can't play/use those words


Steps		What to say/do?
1	Listen carefully	Look at them and stop what you're doing.
2	Say sorry and show you have heard their concerns	"I'm sorry I didn't realise it made you feel I'll stop' "I'm sorry I have upset you, I will stop now"
3	Stop the behaviour and offer words of kindness	"Thanks for telling me, I will be more careful" "Are you okay now?"/ "Shall we do instead"
