## **Attendance**

For all children: 93.3%. 95% is our target.

Every child should aim for 95% or more, but 90%+ avoids being classed as Persistently Absent.

After a great start to the year, in recent weeks our attendance is falling away quite concerningly. There are now 34 children who have an attendance less than 90%, so are missing the equivalent of 1 day every 2 weeks.

- ➤ 9 children = 85%-90% can get above 90% if coming to school every day.
- > 17 children = 90%-92%, so in good position, but mustn't drop.
- > Good news is 127 children have 99% 100% AMAZING!!!!
- > If you would like to know your child's attendance, we can share it with you, just pop to the office.
- > If anyone has any ideas who we can improve some children's attendance, please let us know.
